FILLIES AND MARES, FOUR YEARS OLD AND UPWARD. Free nomination by Sunday, January 14. \$1,250 to enter. \$125,000 Guaranteed. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, and 3% to fifth. Weight: 123 lbs. Non-winners of a graded stakes on turf since July 1 allowed 2 lbs.; a stakes race since July 1, 4 lbs.; three races other than maiden, claiming, or starter, 6 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Supplemental nominations may be made at time of entry. All fees shall be paid prior to the start of the race. This race will be limited to 14 starters, with also eligibles. If more than 14 horses are entered, preference will be given to graded stakes winners, then by highest career earnings. In the event this race is taken off the turf, it will be run at seven furlongs. Trophy to the winning owner. (If deemed inadvisable to run this race over the turf course, it will be run on the main track at Seven Furlongs).

STORMY VICTORIA (FR) was knocked back to last at the break by PERDONA, angled to the inside soon afterward, began moving off the rail still at the rear entering the far turn, swung five wide and rapidly picked up rivals through upper stretch not fully set down, and finished with a flourish roused twice left-handed to be along in time. CELESTINE settled two wide in the middle of the field for the first half-mile, shifted out four wide when given her cue nearing the stretch, rallied to a short lead late, but could not hold off her stablemate. I'M BETTY G tucked in tracking the leaders inside from the start, bid between horses in the two-path a furlong out, and kept on with good courage to hold the show. ALWAYS THINKING lagged well back early two wide, found her best stride three wide turning for home, and was going well late to just miss third. CONQUEST HARD CANDY set the pace inside, shook off TEAM OF TEAMS and STORM THE HILL in upper stretch, and faltered in the last sixteenth of a mile. MISS HOLLYWOOD saved ground and was outrun. WESTIT (GB) was

slow into stride, had a rail trip and could not gain appreciably. STORM THE HILL pressed the pace three wide to the stretch, and weakened through the last furlong. PERDONA bumped STORMY VICTORIA solidly at the start, raced four wide early, and was outrun. TEAM OF TEAMS pressed the pace two wide to the stretch, and gave way between rivals leaving the eighth-pole. GHOSTLY PRESENCE raced four wide much of the way, and lacked a response around the far turn.
