THREE YEAR OLDS. Free nomination by Sunday, January 21. \$2,000 to enter. \$200,000 Guaranteed. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, and 3% to fifth. Weight: 122 lbs. Non-winners of a graded stakes allowed 2 lbs.; a stakes race, 4 lbs.; two races other than maiden, claiming, or starter, 6 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing.

Supplemental nominations may be made at the time of entry. All fees shall be paid prior to the start of the race. This race will be limited to 14 starters, with also eligibles. If more than 14 horses are entered, preference will be given to graded stakes winners, then by highest career earnings. Trophy to the winning owner.

STRIKE POWER broke sharp, cleared the lead and angled in to race just off inside, set the pace through backstretch, continued unasked while rivals were strongly ridden near the quarter pole, responded when called upon at head of the lane, widened advantage on top, stayed in same lead, held clear under firm handling. GOTTA GO was unhurried and saved ground near inside through the backstretch, came under ride in the turn with mild response, gathered momentum along rail in the lane, dueled for runner up spot, produced solid finish to gain runner up spot. DIAMOND KING broke near the back then steadied along inside coming out of chute. bit keen in early stages while being firmly rated before settling more, slipped through along rail and came under ride nearing quarter pole, altered three wide top stretch making contact with TRICKS TO DOO, continued willingly chase but could not reach leader, prevailed for share. TRICKS TO DOO was positioned sharp factor racing just off STRIKE POWER to the turn, roused for more in the far turn, brushed with DIAMOND KING at head of lane, continued with response but lacked needed kick to move on. EMPIRE POWER hopped at the start then raced just off striking range through the backstretch, hustled up three wide in the turn, continued bid entering the lane then weakened in final furlong. PIVEN raced off the pace along outside and lacked response when called upon.
