DREAM TREE three deep into the first turn, stalked off the rail, moved up outside a rival on the second turn, took the lead alongside the pacesetter into the stretch, inched clear nearing midstretch and proved best under a couple left handed cracks off the whip and steady handling then a long hold late. EXUBERANCE off a bit slowly, angled in and saved ground chasing the pace, came out into the stretch, was three wide in deep stretch and edged a rival for the place. STEPH BEING STEPH four wide on the first turn, stalked off the rail, moved up inside on the second turn, came out into the stretch, split horses in deep stretch and was edged for second. THIRTEEN SQUARED sped to the early lead, set the pace inside, dueled into the stretch, was not a match for the winner in the drive and was outfinished late for a minor award. SHE'S NO DRAMA between horses early, stalked off the rail, dropped back leaving the second turn, drifted out into the stretch and weakened. HOLY DIVER broke out and a bit slowly, angled in and settled outside a rival, dropped back and found the inside on the second turn, came out in the stretch and gave way.
