MADAME STRIPES (ARG) hopped in a bit of a slow start, chased outside a rival then a bit off the rail, was between foes a half mile out, continued inside on the second turn, came out into the stretch and again in midstretch, bid three deep under urging in late stretch to gain the lead and gamely prevailed. INSTA ERMA stalked inside then a bit off the rail into the backstretch, split horses with a bid into the second turn, dueled outside the pacesetter, put a head in front nearing midstretch, was between rivals in deep stretch and held second. THUNDERING SKY had good early speed and angled in, set a pressured pace inside, fought back on the second turn and in the stretch and held third. LASEEN (IRE) chased outside a rival then three deep leaving the backstretch, angled to the inside on the second turn, came out into the stretch and was edged for the show. CHOCOLATE COATED three deep early, pressed the pace outside a rival, stalked alongside the winner on the second turn, came out into the stretch and weakened. LADY VALEUR (IRE) chased outside a rival, came out into the stretch and lacked a rally. DO THE DANCE saved ground chasing the pace, dropped back on the second turn and gave way.
